A three-time winner of the Minnesota PGA Junior Golf Leader award, he also served as the PGA Head Professional at Balboa Park GC in San Diego and at Baker National GC in Medina, Minnesota. Michael emphasizes learning by *doing*, rather than *thinking about doing*. You will learn from each and every shot you hit. You won't have to memorize a series of movements, remember a lot of instructions, or try really hard to do anything right. Students will have many choices about how they want to swing a golf club, instead of trying so hard to swing the "right" way. During the golf season Michael co-hosts the TeeMaster Golf Show on AM1500 KSTP radio and appears regularly on the most-watched local golf TV show in Minnesota, Golf Bound on KARE 11.

In 2008, he also became the Head PGA Professional for the Life Time Golf Club in St. Louis Park, an indoor facility for Life Time Fitness.
